Welcome to the 25th edition of an annual newsletter to the friends of Smyrna United Church of Christ Cemetery,\* established in 1891. This newsletter is sent out from the committee as a means to keep in touch with all those who have an interest in the preservation, upkeep, and improvement of one of the historic cemeteries in Clackamas County, Oregon.

February saw the most devastating ice storm in the history of the church, and the church and cemetery sus-

tained significant damage from fallen trees and limbs. Smyrna was in the epicenter of unparalleled ice that caused all the towns and area around to lose power for up to 2 weeks. No sooner had the ice fallen and melted than crews of volunteers arrived to go into action.

A HUGE THANK YOU to all who pitched in and helped with the massive cleanup. Paul Burkert spent days with his chainsaw, and crews of people showed up for many days to haul off the cut up wood and debris. Paul Yoder has spent many hours burning the piles of brush. Yet to be done: restoration of the brick pillar and wrought iron gate, replacement of the damaged chain-link fence, and tree removal and pruning. Fortunately the damages to the grave stones was minor and reparable.



The cemetery is owned by Smyrna United Church of Christ, and it was established in 1891 when the church was built. The church bylaws provide for the election of a committee for management of the cemetery and a separate treasury is maintained.

#### Cemetery Use Policy

Contact Rick Gano, (503) 651-2044, for available locations. A vault is required. A permanent marker is required within six months of burial, unless other arrangements are made with the cemetery. The only restriction on markers is no plastic or resin, and a flat 12 x 24 in. granite or bronze military marker with no concrete border must be used in the cremation garden. No container or vault is required in the Cremation Garden. A plot may be reserved only with purchase of the plot. A \$100 fee may be required at time of burial to go towards a marker.
