How to keep your brain active and lower your risk of Alzheimer's

Here are some simple tips:

- Do household chores, or any other type of low-level activity. (High-level activity is fine too, if you are up to it.)
- Stimulate your brain in different ways. Crossword puzzles, sudoku, etc., are some examples.
- Even sitting down and reading a book for six minutes a day can help lower heart rate and stress levels, as well as muscle tension.
- Eat a primarily plant-based diet, which can increase fiber and decrease intestinal inflammation
- Call a friend or loved one. Brain health can be improved by active social connections. And it can help reduce loneliness or depression




